- ✓ Establish Steering Committee (Complete)
- ✓ Refine Project Scope (Complete)
- ✓ Establish Project Webpage (In Progress)
- ✓ Steering Committee Review of Key Stakeholders (Complete)
- ✓ Stakeholder Interviews (In Progress)



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## Phase 1 – Establishing the Foundation

- ✓ Community Kick-off Meeting
- ✓ Baseline Assessment (In Progress)
  - Community Survey
  - Build-out Analysis
  - Demographic Analysis
  - Review of All Adopted plans
  - Review of Current Community Plan



# Process to Update the Community Plan

## Phase 2 – Exploration of the Vision, Goals and Actions

- ✓ Revisit the Community Vision
- ✓ Create Vision for All Plan Themes
- ✓ Community Vision Meeting/Workshop
- ✓ Finalize vision statements with Steering Committee, Planning Commission and City Council.



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## Phase 2 – Goals and Actions to Reach the Vision

- ✓ Focused community meetings and some open houses on each Plan “theme” such as land use, parks and recreation, economic development, historic preservation, arts and culture.



# Process to Update the Community Plan

## Phase 2 – Goals and Actions to Reach the Vision

- ✓ Create goals and actions based on input to-date, current community plans, comparable communities and other City plans.
- ✓ Steering Committee shapes draft goals and actions with Planning Commission and City Council review.



# Process to Update the Community Plan

## Phase 3 – Drafting the Community Plan

- ✓ Write the draft Community Plan
- ✓ Finalize theme goals and actions
- ✓ Review by Steering Committee with recommendation to Planning Commission.
- ✓ Planning Commission adoption by State Statute.
- ✓ City Council should endorse the Plan.
