## **CITY SLED HILL**

### **Period of Operation**

The sled hill will be closed to vehicle traffic and open for sledding beginning the first of December and will remain open until March 15<sup>th</sup>, weather and conditions permitting. Outside of this timeframe, except for the couple of weeks prior to opening when the sled hill may not be plowed in order to provide snow base for sledding, the road will be plowed and maintained as all other City streets. Once the sled hill is reopened to traffic at the end of the season, the road will once again be maintained for any future snow storms as the rest of the streets within the City.

The sled hill will be open seven days a week, from 7:00 AM until sunset.

Adequate signage will be posted at both the intersections of 5<sup>th</sup> street and 5<sup>th</sup> avenue as well as 5<sup>th</sup> street and 6<sup>th</sup> avenue.

### **Construction of snow berms, barriers, and parking areas**

A snow berm and a barrier will be erected at the top of the sled hill (north side of the 5<sup>th</sup> street and 5<sup>th</sup> avenue intersection). Likewise, a berm and barrier will be erected, blocking the western half of the driving surface at the south side of the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> street and 6<sup>th</sup> avenue. Finally, straw bales will be placed in front of the trees on the west side of the sled hill to provide a barrier.

It is asked that all residents of the street that need to park in the vicinity, to park along the north east side of the block near the 5<sup>th</sup> street and 6<sup>th</sup> avenue intersection. This area will be plowed and sanded by the City. Any snow removal shall be pushed and stored at the south east corner of the intersection until the pile may be removed by the City.

## **Signage**

Proper signage will be posted at both the top and at the base of the sled hill. The following will be posted on the signage:

### Welcome to the Ouray Sled Hill

This sled hill is open from December 1<sup>st</sup> until March 15<sup>th</sup> (conditions permitting).

Please be respectful of the neighbors to this sled hill for graciously supporting this venue for our community.

The sled hill is open from 7:00 AM until sunset

Stay within the public right of way and do not venture onto people's private property.

Only authorized vehicles are allowed in this area

Public restrooms are available at City Hall (west on 6<sup>th</sup> avenue) or at the base of the ski hill (south on 5<sup>th</sup> street)

Sled at your own risk

Along with this signage, proper "Children are Playing" and "Road Closed" signs will also be posted in the general vicinity of the sled hill to warn motorists as they approach the area.

## **Trash receptacles/collection**

Trash receptacles will be placed at the top and bottom of the sled hill and will be cleaned weekly by the Public Works crew.
